#### PRE-SCREENING QUESTIONS

Use these on your application form or in a quick phone screen to filter early.

#### Availability & Commitment

- What days and times are you available to work?
- Are you available on weekends, evenings, and public holidays?
- Do you have any planned vacations or school obligations in the next 3 months?
- How many hours are you hoping to work each week?

#### Work Eligibility

- Are you legally allowed to work in this country?
- Are you under 18? If yes, do you have a valid work permit?
- Are you able to get to work reliably without depending on someone else?

#### Attitude & Reliability

- Have you ever worked in a role where you interacted with customers?
- How do you handle being in a fast-paced environment?
- If you can't make it to a shift, what would you do?



### **INTERVIEW QUESTIONS**

Use these to assess attitude, reliability, and customer service mindset.

#### **Customer Service & Personality**

- Tell me about a time you had to deal with a difficult person. How did you handle it?
- What do you think makes a great customer experience in a place like this?
- What would you do if a child got separated from their parent in the park?
- How would you make sure each guest has a fun and safe experience?

#### Teamwork & Accountability

- Have you ever worked with a team? What role did you usually play?
- What would you do if a teammate wasn't doing their part during a shift?
- How do you feel about doing tasks that are repetitive (like cleaning or ticket scanning)?
- Describe a time you made a mistake at work or school. What did you learn?

#### Reliability & Communication

- What would you do if you were running late for your shift?
- If your manager isn't available, how would you solve a small problem on your own?
- Are you comfortable picking up last-minute shifts or helping cover for a sick teammate?

#### Motivation & Fit

- Why do you want to work here specifically?
- What are you hoping to get out of this job?
- What does "fun but professional" mean to you?
- What would make you excited to come to work every day?

#### Scenario Roleplay

"You're working the prize counter and a parent becomes impatient. How do you handle it?"

#### **Practical Task**

"Explain the safety rules of a ride to a 10-year-old."

#### **Culture Fit Prompt**

"If you saw a teammate break a rule, what would you do?"
